Old Ashbeians Make a Meal of it

A dinner for former students of Ashby School will be held in Ashby in March.

The Old Ashbeians' Association will be holding the event at the Lyric Rooms, Lower Church Street, on Saturday 11 March.

The school's music department will provide entertainment during the evening.

John Exton, Honorary Secretary of the Old Ashbeians' Association, said: "This is a good opportunity for former students of Ashby School to keep in touch with each other and with events at the school."

The meal, which costs £15 a head, will start with leek and potato soup or fruits of the sea baked with chive and shallots with a Parmesan crust.

This will be followed by marinated leg of lamb in a rich currant and black pepper sauce served with fresh seasonal vegetables and potatoes.

For dessert, diners can choose between homemade apple and plum crumble with a pastry case or meringue nests filled with kiwi, raspberries and white chocolate.

Coffee with cream and mints will round off the meal.

Parking is available in the school grounds using the Boarding House entrance.
