



Accessibility Policy

Principle

To try to ensure that every student, member of staff and visitor to the site has access to as many areas and buildings as possible.

Aims and Objectives

- To try ensure that every students has the same access to all areas of the curriculum.
- To try to ensure that every student has the same access to all areas of school life including social areas.
- To try to ensure that all visitors have easy access to buildings and site.

Process

The Senior Administrator and the SENCO have meetings to discuss any problems that may occur with access to the building and any special requirement for the Special Educational Needs Students.

The Senior Administrator has regular contact with the LEA Education Section at County Hall regarding any special requirements that are deemed necessary and to seek help with funding.

All DDA aspects of school life are reported to the Health and Safety committee and where finance is required the Governors' Finance Committee.

A DDA audit is carried out regularly by the LEA and the Senior Administrator and Premises Staff and the SENCO.

If adjustments to the buildings or site are deemed necessary for the students then this are dealt with as a matter of urgency.

Evaluation

By regular consultation with the LEA Premises and Education and by regular consultation with the schools SENCO.

DDA requirements are discussed at the school Health and Safety Committee and the Governors' Finance Committee.
