Support:

- The SEND team are a highly trained team who support students with SEND needs to access their education in the mainstream classroom and also through small group and 1:1 interventions (in literacy and numeracy)
- The pastoral teams provide support in areas such as managing behavior, attendance and social situations. They also facilitate interventions for students who need support regarding their social, emotional and mental health needs

Appropriate Teaching and Learning:

- The school will ensure every student is able to access a full curriculum including trips and extra curricular activities
- Teaching will be adapted through Quality First Teaching strategies to meet your child's needs with additional support where required
- All staff receive training and support to ensure they are able to facilitate the specific needs of students
- Your child will receive 1:1 support if this is a stated requirement within their EHCP (Education, Health and Care Plan)

What can I expect from Ashby School if my child has SEND?

A Partnership Approach

- We work in partnership with you, your child and external agencies to ensure your child's needs are being met and they are able to access a full curriculum successfully
- Internally, the pastoral, SEND and Wellbeing teams work together to provide a comprehensive support package within school
- The school can provide details for organisations that can further support you and your family

Communication

- Staff are made aware of all students' SEND needs by the SEND team, who
 are responsible for uploading SEND information to Arbor (where they can
 be viewed by staff). Any arising SEND changes are added to existing records
 instantly and then communicated to staff
- The SENDCo is available to discuss any SEND related matters. We encourage any lesson related issues to be initially discussed with the subject teacher, as **every** teacher is a teacher of SEND
- Should any SEND related matter arise within school, parents/guardians will be notified accordingly by the SEND team
