

Capture a snapshot of your summer in a 'Photo journal' Year 12 Photography: Summer Assignment

Over the summer holidays you are to create a 'Photo journal' 'snapshot' of your summer. Pick a day or a week, or a trip/event in your summer holiday to document.

Task 1:

Choose a day/week/event/trip in your summer to take photographs of and collect things during that time that can be collaged into/onto your presented Photo journal.

Task 2:

Create a photo journal from your printed photographs and collected items. Collage the photos in a way that captures the time you spent. How you present this photo journal is up to you. E.g. in a sketchbook, tape them together into a concertina, tape them in a grid, three-dimensional presentation, pinboard, digital presentation etc....

The skills you will be marked on:

- Camera control – e.g. sharpness, composition, focal point, settings.
- Creativity with what you have photographed to capture the feelings and scenes and moments of your summer
- The variety of ways you present the photographs – cut, collaged, layered, overlapped, joined etc
- The presentation of the things you collected alongside the photographs.

Deadline for the assignment is the first lesson back after the summer holidays. We would strongly suggest you come to the Art Department (in room A2) to hand it in, even if you don't have photography on that day. This assignment will be your first formal assessment of the A level Photography course. Please make sure your name is clearly visible on the work.
