We are delighted to offer students the opportunity to complete their Silver Duke of Edinburgh Award through Ashby School. Further information about the award can be found further below.

If you are currently in Year 10 and working towards completing your Bronze Award, you are eligible to move straight on to Silver once your Bronze is finished. Students in Year 10 who have not previously completed their Bronze Award are still eligible to join Silver directly through the Direct Silver route.

- Part 1: 5.30pm for Direct Silver an introduction to the award for those students who haven't done their Bronze award
- Part 2: 6.00pm for all Silver Participants a run through of the dates, award structure and costs involved with the opportunity to ask questions

Silver Award Details

The Silver Award comprises several sections, as outlined below. These sections are completed outside of school and therefore require students to make an independent commitment to each area.

Section	Silver Award from	Direct Silver
	Bronze	
Volunteering	6 months	Same as from Bronze plus a further 6
Physical	One for 6 months	months in the Volunteering section or
Skills	One for 3 months	the longer of the Physical or Skills section













In addition to these sections, students must complete the following expeditions:

- Silver Training Residential in the Peak District: Saturday 6th Sunday 7th June 2026
- Silver Practice Expedition in the Peak District: Friday 19th June (PM) Sunday 21st June 2026
- Silver Qualifying Expedition in the Peak District: Friday 11th September (all day) Sunday 13th September 2026

These expeditions are delivered in partnership with Premier Expeditions, a licensed Approved Activity Provider, and supported by Ashby School staff. More information about Premier Expeditions can be found at www.premierexpeditions.co.uk.

Running the Duke of Edinburgh's Award is an optional enrichment programme and not funded by the school. Ashby School serves as the students' DofE authorising body, supporting them in registering, managing and evidencing their progress.

While final costs depend on participant numbers, the provisional cost for the Silver Award is around £330. This does not include transport to and from the expedition locations, and we ask for parental support with this where possible. Financial assistance is available for Pupil Premium students.
