Communication Update

Following feedback regarding the volume of emails received from school, we have reviewed our strategy and as a trial from the start of next term we will be moving some communications to the School Newsletter and/or Arbor App notifications. We advise you to allow push notifications on the Arbor App, if you haven't already done this. If you don't have this enabled, you may still receive emails to inform you when a notification is sent to you. You will still receive some communications via email, including the fortnightly newsletter, urgent notices, specific trip information for your child and behaviour communications. Safeguarding - Kayleigh's Love Story – You may have seen in the BBC Leicester News recently that they covered 'Kayleigh's Love Story, about Leicestershire teenager Kayleigh Haywood, who was murdered in 2015 after being groomed online. Kayleigh was a student at Ashby and was taught by teachers who are still working here today. Our Head of School KS5 and Safeguarding Lead, Mrs Rundle-Brown spoke to the BBC for their report. It is important for Ashby School/Sixth Form to always remember Kayleigh and we are passionate about turning such an awful tragedy into something that potentially could save students' lives in the future. 








What's been happening...

Year 7 Maths - Two Coloured Counters - In Year 7 we have been teaching directed numbers this term. Our approach to these involves using two-coloured counters to help students to grasp the concept. Often students struggle with directed numbers as historically they are asked to remember a lot of rules that don't make sense. Through using two coloured counters we introduce the concept of a zero pair, with red counters and yellow counters becoming zero together. This really helps students to build a conceptual understanding of what is happening with directed number calculations. We have been doing this with our Year 7s for the last 3 years and, anecdotally, we are seeing far fewer errors with negatives compared to before, later on in their school careers.



Year 10 Textiles – Jessica Grady Workshop - Year 10 textiles students, along with a group of A-Level Textiles students, recently took part in an inspiring workshop led by textile artist Jessica Grady. Throughout the session, students experimented with a range of decorative textile techniques, creating beautifully intricate samples linked to the themes of their current projects. The workshop offered them an exciting opportunity to explore new materials, develop their creative confidence, and refine their practical skills in a professional context. Jessica was extremely impressed with the high standard of work produced and praised the students' creativity and enthusiasm. Mrs Sheldon, who organised and supported the workshop, echoed this sentiment and looks forward to welcoming Jess back to Ashby again in the near future.
