APPRENTICESHIP ACADEMY



We are delighted to inform you that Ashby School has invested in a new programme called the Apprenticeship Academy. It allows us to register any of our Year 10-13 students who are considering or seeking an apprenticeship to ensure they have everything they need to be successful on their journey.

It is of the utmost importance to us that our students are able to get specialist advice on all their options when they finish their education with us. If your child has an interest in finding an apprenticeship, the programme will cover the following topics:

- Week 1: What Apprenticeship am I looking for?
- Week 2: Where can I find Apprenticeships?
- Week 3: How can I write successful applications?
- Week 4: What will the application process be?
- Week 5: How can I approach interviews and assessments?



The sessions are led by a qualified careers advisor who will provide students with tailored support and advice during the 5-week programme which runs online on Wednesdays from 4.00pm to 5.30pm. **The start date will be Wednesday 10th June and a letter detailing how to sign up will be sent out to parents and students shortly.**

EXCITING APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITIES WITH LINDE - APPRENTICE ENGINEER PROGRAMME 2026

Linde have partnered with SMB College to deliver the 3-year Lift Truck and Powered Access Engineering Technician Apprenticeship (Level 3).



Over the three years, apprentices spend a target 24 weeks in training (excluding end point assessment) at SMB College in Leicester. This training is arranged into two-week blocks, Monday to Friday. Applicants must be willing and able to travel to complete their college study.

Progression routes could include qualified engineer, technical or specialist roles.

Practical Training

Training is made up of on-the-job and off-the-job training.

80% of the apprenticeship will be spent working with your employer.

20% of the time will be allocated to off-the-job training: this will be a mixture of college blocks, internal training, assignments and revision.

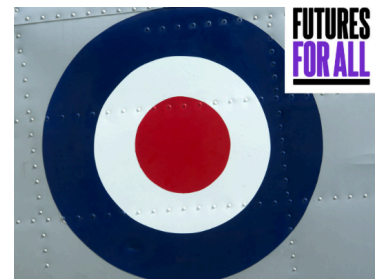

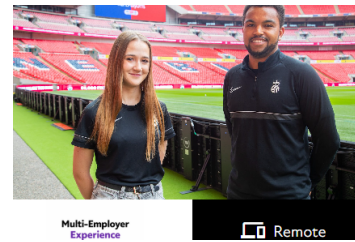

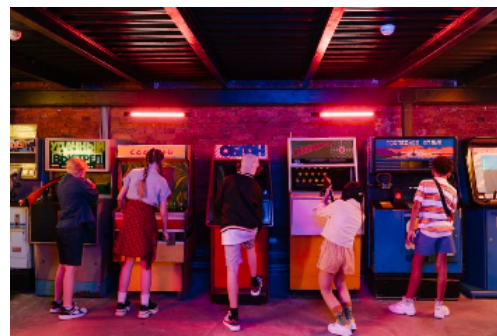
