GCSE Results Day

Dear Student/Parent/Carer

As you will be aware, GCSE results will be released on Thursday 20th August this year. We will be distributing these results face to face from the Sports Hall in B Block, on the Sixth Form Campus (Leicester Road) from 8.40am until 10:30am. All students must bring photo ID in order to collect their results. (School ID badges will be acceptable forms of ID). If students do not hold a form of photo ID, they may bring two forms of non-photo ID. If students do not bring ID, they may not be able to collect their results and will need to wait for them to be posted home.

If students are unable to collect the results personally, they may nominate someone else to collect on their behalf but will need to email exams@ashbyschool.org.uk from their school email address, by 8th August, with the name of their nominated person and their relationship to that person. The nominated person will also need to bring a copy of the student's photo ID. Please collect the results from the Sports Hall, detailed above. If nobody is able to collect the results in person, they will be posted home first class in the afternoon of 20th August. Please ensure school has your most up to date address if you have recently moved.

Information regarding 'post-result services' will be emailed to parents/carers before results day. Please ensure you have read this information before collecting your results. The same information will also be provided in the results day envelope. A member of staff from the exams office will be available on results day to answer any questions you may have regarding post-result services and teachers will be available to advise with subject-specific queries.

Sixth Form

If students have applied for Ashby Sixth Form and meet both overall and subject entry requirements they will need to confirm their place on results day. This can be done using a simple QR code which students will find in their results day envelope and around the sports hall. If students have not met subject entry requirements or have any queries regarding their Sixth Form subject choices following results, they will be directed to a member of the Sixth Form Team who will support them with next steps. Mr Talbot will also be available to chat with any students who have not met our overall entry requirements. As places and subjects are in high demand, any student who has not confirmed their place by 2pm, may be removed from the application database and their place may be offered to someone else. The nominated person collecting results can also confirm places on a student's behalf.
