TEXT 1: Porphyria's Lover	2. Open the Porphyria's Lover folder and then the PPT. The PPT outlines all activities to complete.

	4. Complete the glossary match up on PPT slide 5 and the ordering of events on PPT slide 6.	*
	5. Answer the 10 questions about the poem (PPT slide 7-8), analysing the text closely and recording your answers either on a word document, or on paper.	*
TEXT 2: The Lottery	6. Now open the 'The Lottery' folder and PPT. – the PPT outlines all activities to complete.

	9. Answer the 8 questions about the short story (PPT slide 8), analysing the text closely and recording your answers either on a word document, or on paper.	*
